Terms of the Howard V. Sandin Memorial Scholarship

Applications are reviewed by the Scholarship Committee of the hospital and should be submitted in writing along with other pertinent information such as scholastic records, financial needs, and references. Applications should be sent to the Scholarship Committee, Memorial Medical Center, 1615 Maple Lane, Ashland, WI 54806.

The scholarship loan will be considered for renewal every year upon application to the Scholarship Committee.

The recipient agrees that upon graduation, he/she will accept full-time employment at Memorial Medical Center, Inc. at the prevailing salary for a period of one (1) year. If more than one scholarship loan is given, the recipient agrees to accept full-time employment for at least two (2) years. At the end of this period, the sum loaned by Memorial Medical Center shall be considered as repaid in full.

Should Memorial Medical Center be unable to hire the recipient because of a full quota of employees or for any other reason, the obligation to repay the loan is forgiven.

Should the recipient fail, for any reason, to complete the training or educational program for which assistance is given, the loan shall be repaid to Memorial Medical Center within twelve (12) months with six percent (6%) interest per annum.

Should the recipient fail to accept or complete employment at Memorial Medical Center, Inc., under the terms listed above, the amount granted, plus six percent (6%) interest per annum shall be repaid in full no later than one (1) year after graduation.

The scholarship will not be available to the student until he/she has been fully accepted by the educational institution.
